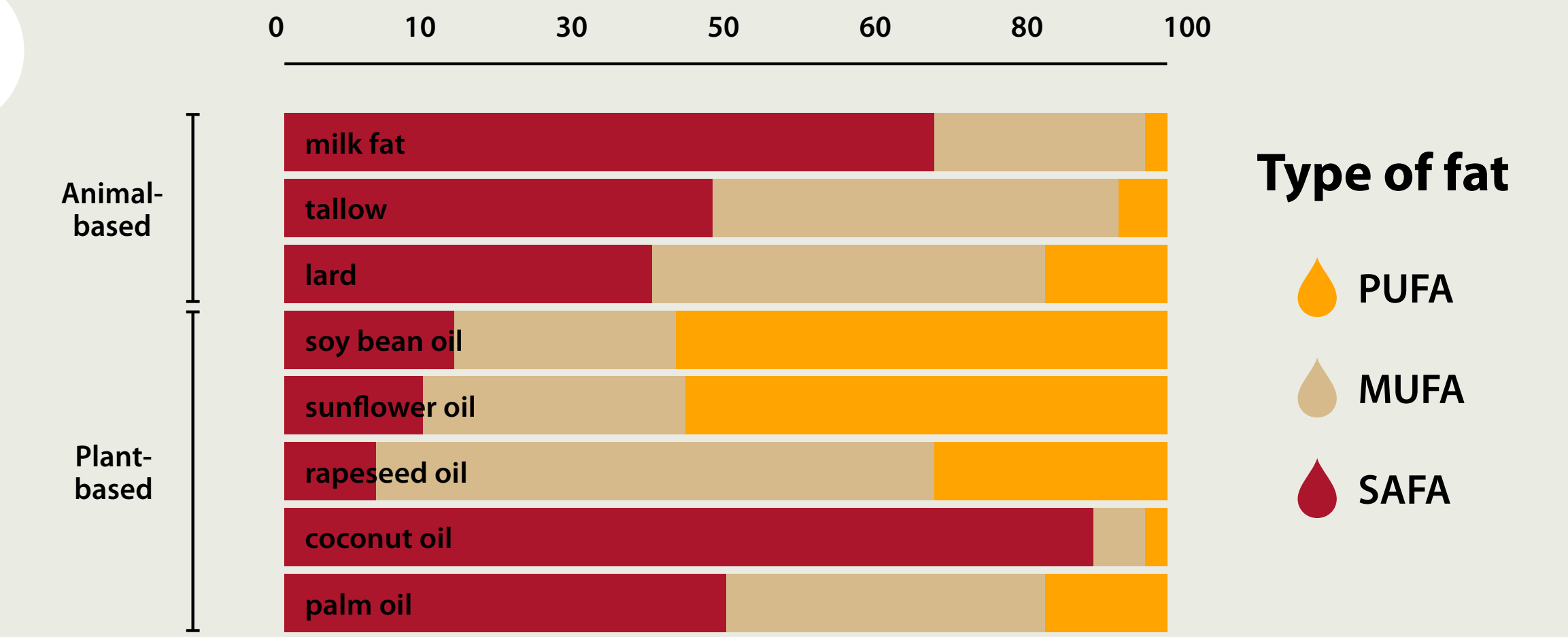
From the fruits of palm oil tree

Each fruit content 30-35% oil

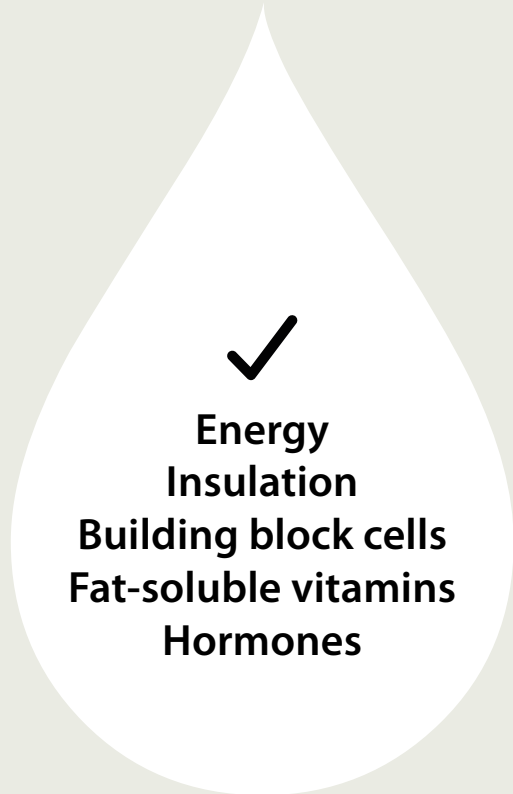

Daily intake recommended by WHO

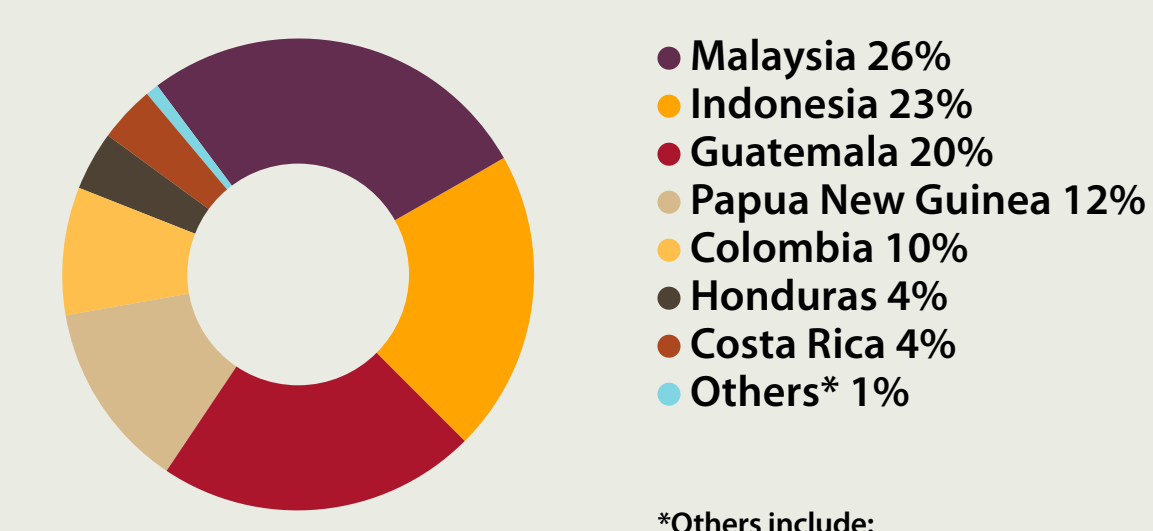
